WE WERE ALL SADDENED LAST JANUARY BY THE ANNOUNCEMENT OF THE DEATH (IN SAN DIEGO, CALIFORNIA) of Bishop Dermot O'Flanagan, the first Bishop of Juneau, and many remember the solemn rites of the burial Mass at that time. Bishop O'Flanagan's remains will be interred in the priests' plot at Angelus Memorial Park on Friday, June 8th, at 11 a.m.; Mass will be celebrated by all of the participating clergy at 12:10 at Holy Family Cathedral on the same date. His Excellency, Archbishop Ryan, in a letter to the parish this week, has invited all parishioners of the Archdiocese to attend both the interment at the cemetery and the Mass at the Cathedral in memory of Bishop O'Flanagan.
