Each year a special collection, called Peter's Pence, is taken up in churches throughout the Catholic world and forwarded to the Holy Father. This collection is scheduled for July 8 in the Archdiocese of Anchorage.

Since last year's collection in July we have lived through the deaths of two Popes, Pope Paul VI and Pope John Paul I, and seen the election of the first Polish Pope, John Paul II. The impact of Pope John Paul II on the world in the short months since his elevation has been electrifying. Crowds of people are flocking to Rome just to get a glimpse of him in his general audiences. When he travels TV newscasts record the outpouring of love from people of all nations and all denominations.

At the same time Pope John Paul has reminded all of the obligation to reach out to the poor. He himself wishes to do that -- and we can enable him to do so. The appeal for Peter's Pence this year, therefore, is to strengthen the hand of Pope John Paul II as he reaches out to the world.

I ask all to be generous, very generous, to think in terms of a significant personal sacrifice as a show of support for all that the Holy Father is and all that he hopes to do.
