Sr. Julie Adams will be offering scripture classes on the Epistles of St. Paul. These classes will be offered in the evenings, dates to be announced later.

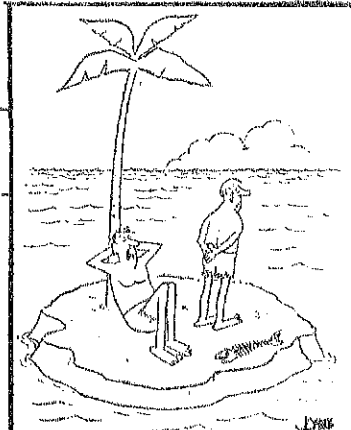
