### REPORT ON MEETINGS HELD THIS WEEK:

The meeting of the parishioners on Wednesday evening was attended by only a few people other than Advisory Board and Committee members. The presentation to the Archbishop was gone over and explained. The problem of cleaning of St. Jude Center was brought up and there was much discussion on ways of handling this. It was decided that each group or organization using the building for meetings or other purposes, will be required to clean up after themselves, remove all garbage from the building and be responsible for the lights being turned off and the door locked. A dumpster will be placed in a convenient location for the three buildings. Two cleaning committees will be named each month, one for Sacred Heart and one for St. Jude Center. It is hoped that everyone using the building will cooperate with these rules in order that our beautiful new building can remain the source of pride that it is today. Remember - Cleanliness is next to Godliness! !

At the meeting on Thursday with Archbishop Hurley, the packet containing reports of committees, building construction costs, and financial statement, was presented to him and he re-acted very favorably to what has been happening in our parish. He gave permission for us to use the \$15,000 of promissory note funds, to purchase furnishings and equipment for the new building.
