What is the Plan of Pastoral Action for Family Ministry?

The Plan of Pastoral Action for Family Ministry, endorsed by  
the Roman Catholic bishops of the United States in May of 1978, is a  
vehicle for the church's efforts to assist contemporary families in  
realizing their mission and potential within the church and the wider  
society. Subtitled "A Vision and Strategy," the Plan presents both a  
vision of family ministry and a strategy for carrying it out.

The Plan recognizes the family as that primary community that  
affirms, supports and provides the friendship and care we all need as  
we develop and grow as Christian and human persons. It notes that the  
survival of the family cannot be taken for granted, that the full  
resources of the church should be available for enrichment and assist-  
ance of families everywhere.
