CUBAN AND HAITIAN REFUGEES: These tens of thousands of men, women and children, over 90% Catholic, who are escaping political and religious repression and dire economic conditions, need our help and prayers. The Cubans are anti-Communists and have lost all rights to their own lands and property because of their stand.

The U. S. Catholic Conference is one of 12 volunteer agencies that staff processing centers and conduct interviews with these people when they enter our country. This organization will be involved in the majority of re-settlements because of their Catholic faith and they place a greater trust in a Catholic Organization.

So far these refugees have not been granted official refugee status by the federal government so they are not eligible for federal benefits. Without government funds, programs such as those conducted by the U. S. Catholic Conference are in dire need of money to finance day to day needs of these people to help them get started in a new life.


How can we help? - To have an awareness of the Refugee situation as a local community and to do something positive by OUR PRAYERS, and OUR GIFTS.
