Adult catechesis is also relevant to the Church's mission on behalf of justice, mercy, peace, and respect for human life - a mission which depends heavily upon informed and motivated lay people. Adults need to learn and practice the gospel demands of stewardship. God gives everyone a measure of personal time, talent and treasure to use for His glory and the service of neighbor.

Because of its importance and because all other forms of catechesis are oriented in some way to it, the catechesis of adults must have high priority at all levels of the Church. The success of programs for children and youth depends to a significant extent upon the words, attitudes, and actions of the adult community, especially parents, family and guardians."
