The word POPE comes from the Greek: PAPAS, meaning Father. The Pope is often referred to as PONTIFF: a bridge builder. He is addressed: Your Holiness.

The Roman Pontiff is elected by the College of Cardinals in Rome. He is the Bishop of Rome, the Vicar of Christ on earth, the successor of St. Peter. The Pope is the perpetual and visible principle and foundation of unity of both the bishops and laity.

Cardinal Karol Wojtyla was elected to the Papacy by the College of Cardinals on October 16, 1978 following the short reign of Pope John Paul I. He assumed the name of John Paul II.

He is well qualified to be the most important religious leader in the world. Not only is he a man of God, totally committed to the Church, but he is a writer, a poet, a philosopher, a theologian. He is a leader, exuding confidence by his very person, speaking calmly, listening intently, and keeping in touch with the people.

Coming from Poland, a country suffering under Communist domination, he believes in and champions loyalty, social justice, peace, and has great concern for the youth, for the poor and the oppressed.
