Bring Volleyballs, softballs, bats, frisbees, balloons, etc. silverware and plates for your family.

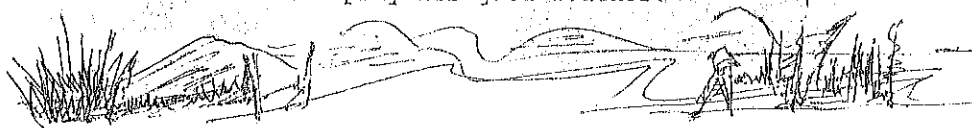

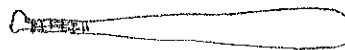

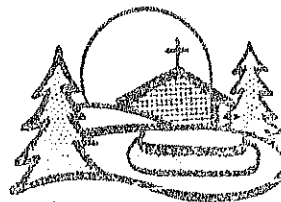

If you follow this light, wherever it leads

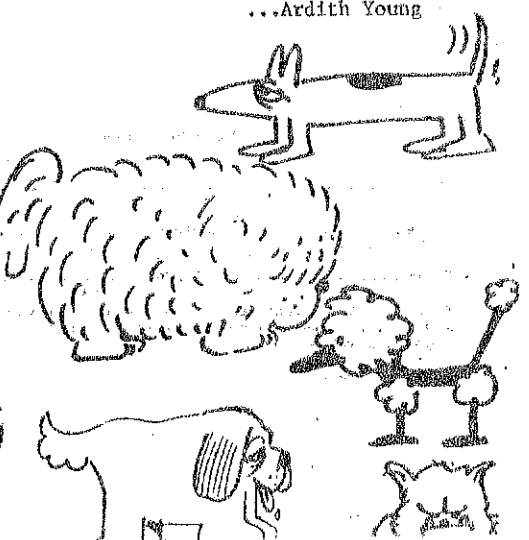

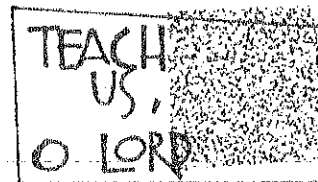
