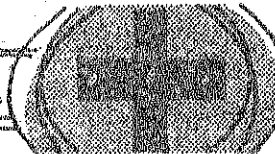
SOFTBALL GAME - Didn't find out the score but Sacred Heart won last week. Next game will be July 5 against the Assembly of God.
