Findings of Catholic Elementary Education Survey

Thirty-four (34) families have indicated their interest in Catholic Elementary Education making a total of 54 children between the ages of 5 and 12.

Five (5) families expressed interest in Montessori Kindergarten. The maximum number of children that could be registered would be 24 for the Fall of 1982 if a suitable facility could be located.

Projection for Elementary Education could be as soon as Fall of 1981 or 1982 depending upon parental support, continued favorable results from this study, development of a fitting plan and renting, buying or building a facility.

So far interest and verbal support has been very favorable on all levels.
