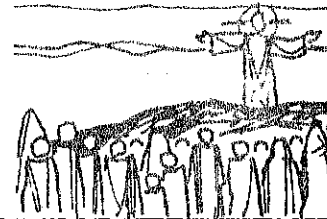

Here in Anchorage there has been a notable development. Many of our sisters began in parishes as religious education coordinators. Over a period of time, especially in one-priest parishes, the sisters were approached by the people for many types of help traditionally referred to as priest. In effect they assumed in part the role of assistant pastor.

Basically the new thrust in ministries in the Church has opened up many new possibilities for religious and lay to function directly in pastoral care in the parishes. This in turn opens up new possibilities in the development of priests, according to local needs and the talents of the priest.

Some functions, as noted above, are the exclusive domain of the priest. Thus, on weekends a priest will go to Wasilla not only for Mass but for other sacraments and for any special help he can bring.

At the request of the parish council each priest that supplies there will go four consecutive weekends, to arrive on Friday night and remain until Sunday night. In such a pattern he will be able to get an appreciation of the life of the parish and exercise another essential role of a priest, to evaluate how faithful the witness of the parish is to the gospel message.

Sister Elmer assumes a grave responsibility but she does so with a wealth of experience as an administrator and an educator, with the support of the people of Wasilla, with the encouragement of the priest and religious of the Archdiocese--and the prayers of all.

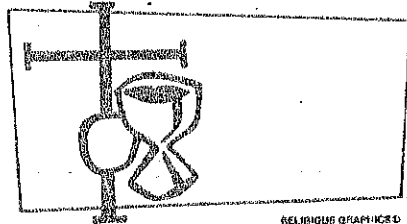

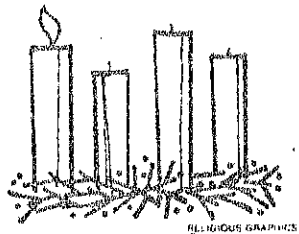
