ERNEST LEROY PECK

November 9, 1889 - September 14, 1982

Ernest LeRoy Peck came to Alaska in 1912. His long life in Alaska is filled with a wealth of history. On January 22, 1920 Olga Tallek-pellik and Ernest Peck were joined in holy matrimony at St. Michael, Alaska.

We knew Ernie as a wireless operator, teacher, and bookkeeper. His warmth came through in his storytelling.

In a special way, the seed of faith was brought to Wasilla in 1930 in the persons of Mr. and Mrs. Ernest Peck and family and Rose Peck, the only Catholics then in Wasilla.

So far as we can determine, the first Mass celebrated in Wasilla was on the Peck property by Father James Snead for the St. Michael's annual parish picnic. This was an outdoor Mass.

Part of the Peck property was purchased by Mr. and Mrs. Robert Rourick. According to the Rouricks, it is through the inspiration of the Pecks that some of this property was donated in the mid 60's to the newly established Archdiocese of Anchorage with the stipulation that a catholic church be built on it. This became the site of Sacred Heart Church.
