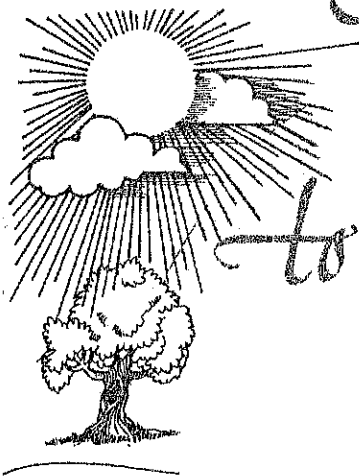
WELCOME to Sacred Heart to newly registered Allen and Sheila Dickman and 3 year old son Justin. We hope your stay is long and happy here.

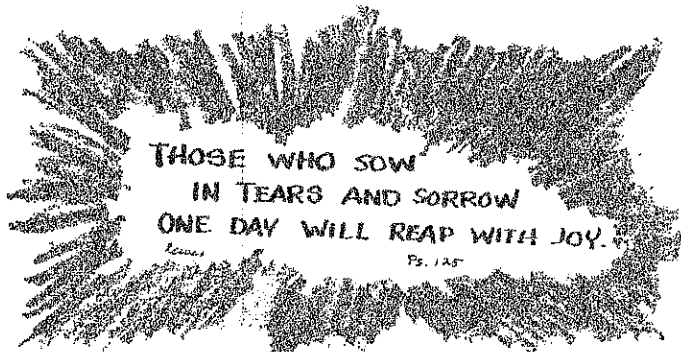

PROPOSAL BY PARISH COUNCIL. The Council proposes the following amendment to the CONSTITUTION - ARTICLE VI Section I(A): "A general election of Council members shall be held the (first Sunday of October) and the newly elected members will take office at the next regular meeting of the Council" to read: (SECOND SUNDAY IN JANUARY). The Council has expressed that it would be more feasible to have elections in January rather than in October.

Amendments to the Constitution requires the approval of the parish. A vote on this proposal will take place next Sunday, September 4 at all the Masses: 8:00 a.m., 9:30 a.m. and 7:00 p.m.
