PROPOSAL BY PARISH COUNCIL. The Council proposes the following amendment to the CONSTITUTION - **ARTICLE VI Section 1(A):** "A general election of Council members shall be held the (first Sunday of October) and the newly elected members will take office at the next regular meeting of the Council" to read: "(SECOND SUNDAY IN JANUARY)". The Council has expressed that it would be more feasible to have elections in January rather than in October.

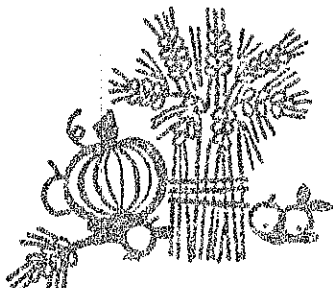
