

Parish Pastoral Council Summary, January 1, 2015  
Established August 2012: Father Scott J. Garrett

First Members: Mary Hugh McGowen, John Mahoney, Steve Cochran, Karen Smith, Hilma Barrera, Angelina Klapperich, and Rob Vitt.

**August 25, 2012:** Established Goals (outreach, youth, Adult Ed, OLV), reviewed Archdiocese manual, started Sacred Heart Mission statement.

**October 20, 2012:** Discussed four phases of building new school, outreach and youth programs. Completed Sacred Heart Mission statement:  
**Building a family of faith on a bedrock of Catholic principles; Providing spiritual direction and education in hope; Serving Christ through serving others in a community of outreach of love.**

**February 8, 2013:** Chose seven local charities to make yearly donations of \$1000 each, established youth mass/activities, discussed entrance sign and billboards for four phase school building project.

**May 25, 2013:** Discussed 20 year goals for religious education, Our Lady of the Valley, youth, landscaping. Decided on granite entrance sign.

**September 7, 2013:** Update on outreach programs; established youth mass (last Sunday of month, home school will organize activities, Sacred Heart responsible for scheduling youth mass ministries); discussed taking children out of Mass before Homily for Breaking Open the Word on readings, discussed welcoming cards/baskets for new parishioners.

**January 10, 2014:** Discussed Adoration, youth activities, outreach donations, hospitality baskets, Tabernacle pedestal, stopping blue envelope maintenance 2<sup>nd</sup> collection, digitalizing office paperwork, feasibility of building school.

**May 17, 2014:** Discussed how to allow parishioners to have more input into the Parish Pastoral Council; established electronic question box and prayer request form on our website; discussed statue in front of All Saints Building.

**November 16, 2014:** Member Update (Rob Vitt was transferred by the military). Chose Emily Cullison as a new member and discussed Maria Serrano as a possible youth representative. Elected officers. Emily introduced herself, discussed having a council member at every finance council meeting, discussed ways to get parishioners more involved, (i.e. inviting special interest group leaders to meetings, rejected having open meetings to the public for purposes of productivity).
